

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

IQAC as a Statutory Committee:

IQAC is a statutory body **mandated by the University Grants Commission (UGC)** under the **National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) guidelines**.

As per **NAAC guidelines** and **UGC regulations**, every accredited institution must establish an IQAC to institutionalize quality assurance and enhancement mechanisms.

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Functions of IQAC:

1. Develop quality benchmarks for academic and administrative activities.
 2. Facilitate a learner-centric environment for quality education.
 3. Encourage faculty development for quality enhancement.
 4. Collect and analyze feedback from all stakeholders.
 5. Document and report quality improvement initiatives.
 6. Prepare the **Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR)** and submit it to NAAC.
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Composition of IQAC (As per NAAC):

1. Chairperson – Head of the Institution (Principal)
2. Teachers (3 to 8 members)
3. Senior administrative officers

4. Management representative
5. Nominees from:
 - Local society
 - Students
 - Alumni
 - Employers
 - Industrialists/stakeholders
6. One of the senior teachers – Coordinator/Director of IQAC
