#### Student Grievance Redressal Committee - As a Statutory Committee

The Student Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC/CGRC) is a **statutory body** constituted under the **UGC Grievance Redressal Regulations, 2018** to ensure fair and timely redressal of student complaints in higher educational institutions. This committee is responsible for upholding student rights and fostering a transparent and accountable academic environment.

### **Statutory Basis:**

- **UGC Grievance Redressal Regulations, 2018**: Mandates establishment of structured grievance redressal mechanisms at college and university levels.
- Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016: Supports formation of grievance committees to protect student welfare.
- **AICTE/NAAC Guidelines**: Recommend transparent processes and grievance resolution frameworks to improve student services.

### **Objectives of the Statutory SGRC:**

- To provide a platform for students to raise academic, administrative, or personal concerns.
- To resolve grievances in a fair, time-bound, and student-friendly manner.
- To promote student satisfaction and ensure institutional accountability.
- To protect student rights related to admissions, fees, scholarships, and documents.

#### **Functions of SGRC (Statutory Role):**

- Address student grievances related to admissions, fees, scholarships, facilities, examinations, or harassment.
- Act upon unresolved complaints from departmental committees (DGRC/IGRC).
- Conduct hearings following principles of natural justice and confidentiality.
- Submit findings and recommendations to the Vice-Chancellor of the affiliating university.
- Coordinate with University Grievance Redressal Committee (UGRC) for escalated cases.

### **Rules and Regulations:**

- Ensure publication of detailed prospectus with all academic and financial information.
- Resolve grievances within 15–30 days, depending on severity.
- Maintain transparency in handling student documents and fee structures.
- Guarantee timely disbursement of scholarships and benefits.
- Preserve student rights without coercion or bias and ensure non-retaliation.
