(Statutory Committee as per Section 97, Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016)

Women Development Cell (WDC) – As a Statutory Committee

The Women Development Cell (WDC) is a statutory committee established in accordance with the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (POSH Act), and guidelines issued by UGC/AICTE, to promote gender equality, ensure women's safety, and address issues related to women's welfare within an institution.

Statutory Basis:

- POSH Act, 2013: Mandates the formation of an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) at workplaces and educational institutions to handle sexual harassment complaints.
- UGC Regulations, 2015: Requires all higher educational institutions to establish a Women's Grievance Redressal Cell.
- AICTE & NAAC Guidelines: Encourage institutions to form a Women Development Cell to ensure gender sensitization and women's welfare.

In many institutions, **WDC either functions as or in conjunction with the ICC**, giving it a **statutory role**.

Objectives of the Statutory WDC:

- Prevent and address cases of sexual harassment and gender-based violence.
- Promote gender sensitization through training, workshops, and campaigns.
- Ensure a safe, equitable, and respectful environment for all genders.
- Provide support and redressal mechanisms for women's issues.

Composition (As per POSH Act / UGC Guidelines):

- **Presiding Officer**: Senior woman faculty (Head of WDC)
- Faculty Members: At least 2 committed to women's issues
- Non-Teaching Staff Member
- Student Representatives (in educational institutions)
- External Member: From NGO or legal background, familiar with women's rights

Functions of WDC (Statutory Role):

- Conduct inquiries into complaints of sexual harassment.
- Submit annual reports to the appropriate authority.
- Create awareness and conduct sensitization programs.
- Recommend institutional policies for gender equity and women's safety.

Rules and Regulations:

- Follow POSH Act, 2013 procedures for complaints and inquiry.
- Ensure confidentiality and fair process in all proceedings.
- Regularly organize gender sensitization and legal awareness programs.
- Submit periodic reports to institutional authorities and governing bodies.
